BY-LAW No. 10

Professional Liability Insurance

Interpretation

1. In this By-law,
 - a) "By-laws" means all by-laws of the College;
 - b) "College" means the College of Massage Therapists of Ontario;
 - c) "general certificate of registration" is a certificate of registration of the general class issued by the Registrar;
 - d) "member" means a member of the College, which means a person registered by the College;
 - e) "Registrar" means the Registrar of the College or the Deputy Registrar of the College.

Professional Liability Insurance

2. An applicant for the issuance of a general certificate of registration must provide to the College, prior to the issuance of the certificate of registration, proof that the applicant holds a policy of professional liability insurance that meets the requirements prescribed by this By-law.
3. A member who holds a general certificate of registration must hold, or otherwise be covered by, a policy of professional liability insurance that meets the requirements of this By-law, and must provide the College with proof of the policy with the annual renewal of registration form prescribed by the Registrar, and as otherwise required by the College.
4. All members holding a general certificate of registration must hold, or otherwise be covered by, a policy of professional liability insurance that meets the following requirements:
 - a) The policy must provide a minimum of \$2,000,000 in coverage annually for professional liability.
 - b) The policy must be written on an occurrence form.

Administration

5. This By-law shall be administered by the Registration Committee.
6. This By-law comes into force on the day enacted.
