Discipline Hearing Summary

Jose Mira Nava (Toronto, ON)

November 28-29, 2018

Decision

On June 5, 2019, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Nava, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. sexually abused a client; and
2. contravened a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failed to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession;
3. physically abused a client;
4. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
5. engaged in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by registrants as conduct unbecoming a Massage Therapist.

Pending a penalty hearing, and pursuant to subsection 51(4.2)(c) of the Health Professions Procedural Code, the Panel made an interim order suspending Mr. Nava's Certificate of Registration immediately upon making a finding that he had sexually abused a client and the sexual abuse consisted of touching of a sexual nature.

A penalty hearing will be scheduled for the near future.
