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Discipline Hearing Summary

Scott Brown (St. Catharines, ON)

September 15, 2020

Decision

On November 16, 2020, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Brown, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. failed to co-operate with an authorized representative of the College (a College investigator) conducting an inspection or examination of the registrant's office, records, equipment or practice;
2. failed to keep records as required;
3. contravened the *Massage Therapy Act, 1991*, the *Regulated Health Professions Act, 1991*, or the regulations under either of those Acts, more particularly section 11(5) of Ontario Regulation 544/94 under the *Massage Therapy Act, 1991*; and
4. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.
