Discipline Hearing Summary

Ramil Reyes (Toronto, ON)

January 12-14, 29, 2021

Decision

On August 11, 2021, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Reyes committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. sexually abused a client;
2. contravened a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failed to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession, in particular the Standard for *Maintaining Professional Boundaries and Preventing Sexual Abuse*;
3. physically abused a client; and
4. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of Massage Therapy that would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The findings arose from Mr. Reyes' conduct toward a client during a Massage Therapy treatment, which involved touching of a sexual nature of the client's breast. Given this finding of sexual abuse, the Discipline Committee issued an interim order suspending Mr. Reyes' Certificate of Registration. The interim order came into effect on August 11, 2021 and stays in effect until the Discipline Committee decides on the appropriate penalty.
