Discipline Hearing Summary – Adam Muklewicz, RMT

(Mississauga, ON)

November 29, 2016

Decision

On November 29, 2016, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Adam Muklewicz, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. Practised massage therapy while his Certificate of Registration was suspended;
2. Received a benefit from the practice of massage therapy while under suspension;
3. Signed or issued in his professional capacity a document that he knew contained a false or misleading statement;
4. Engaged in conduct or performed an act, in the course of practicing the profession, that having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional;
5. Failed to take reasonable steps to ensure information he provided to the College-appointed investigator was accurate;
6. Failed to cooperate with the College-appointed investigator; and
7. Failed to keep records as required.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

1. The Registrar is directed to suspend Mr. Muklewicz's Certificate of Registration for a period of seven months;
2. Mr. Muklewicz is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
3. Mr. Muklewicz is required to pay the College costs in the amount of \$4,000; and
4. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the ordinary course. Additionally, the College may publish, at the direction of the Registrar, details of the Member's failure to comply with any of the terms of the penalty imposed.
