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Discipline Hearing Summary – Andrey Kojevnikov, RMT

(Greater Toronto Area, ON)

January 15, 2016

Decision

On January 15, 2016, the CMTO's Discipline Committee found that Mr. Andrey Kojevnikov, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

- 1) Failed to keep records as required;
- 2) Falsified records relating to his practice;
- 3) Signed and issued documents in his professional capacity that he knew contained false statements;
- 4) Engaged in conduct relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
- 5) Failed to provide the information required upon the renewal of his Certificate of Registration.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

1. A public and recorded reprimand;
2. A suspension of the Certificate of Registration for nine consecutive months;
3. Imposition of the following terms, conditions, and limitations on the Certificate of Registration:
 - a. Successful completion of the College's Record Keeping Course and Professionalism Workshop, at the registrant's own expense, within 12 months, and;
 - b. Submission to an inspection of the registrant's practice, at the registrant's own expense, within 12 months of resuming practice;
4. Publishing of this Discipline Committee decision in the usual course.
