<p><u>Interpretation</u></p> <p>4. The initial fee to issue an inactive certificate to a registrant <b>and the annual fee for an inactive certificate of registration</b> shall be <b>\$200<del>175</del></b> for 2015<del>9</del> and in subsequent years, <b>Council shall annually review the fees and where Council deems it appropriate, in any one or more years, this amount shall<del>may</del> be subject to an increase of not more than the annual inflation rate rounded to the nearest dollar.</b></p>
<p>6. Every registrant shall pay an annual fee to the College by November 1 each year, for the following year.</p>	<p>6. Every registrant shall pay an annual fee to the College by <b>December 31, 2018 for the fees owing for 2019, and by November 1 in each subsequent year for the fees owing for the following year.</b></p>
