

Discipline Hearing Summary – Nathanael Enns, RMT (Waterloo, ON)

September 15, 2017

Decision

On September 15, 2017, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Enns, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. Has been found guilty of an offence that is relevant to his suitability to practise;
2. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
3. Engaged in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming of a Massage Therapist.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

1. Mr. Enns is required to appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee immediately following the hearing of this matter to be reprimanded, with the fact of the reprimand and a summary of the reprimand to appear on the public register of the College;
2. The Registrar is directed to suspend Mr. Enns' Certificate of Registration for a period of two (2) months, effective immediately;
3. The Registrar is directed to impose the following terms, conditions or limitations on Mr. Enns' Certificate of Registration:
 - a. Mr. Enns must, at his own expense, successfully complete, in the opinion of the Registrar, the College's Professionalism Workshop within three (3) months of the date of the Discipline Committee's Order; and
 - b. Mr. Enns must, at his own expense, successfully complete, in the opinion of the Registrar, the College's Standards and Regulations E-Workshop within six (6) months of the date of the Discipline Committee's Order.
4. Mr. Enns is required to pay to the College costs in the amount of \$3,000.00 within six (6) months of the date of the Discipline Committee's order.
