

## **Discipline Hearing Summary – Jian Feng Feng, RMT (Greater Toronto Area, ON) October 13, 2017**

### **Decision**

On October 13, 2017, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Feng, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

1. Falsified a record relating to the registrant's practice;
2. Signed or issued, in the registrant's professional capacity, a document that the registrant knew contained a false or misleading statement; and
3. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

### **Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed**

The Discipline Committee made the following Order:

1. Mr. Feng is required to appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee immediately following the hearing of this matter to be reprimanded, with the fact of the reprimand and the text of the reprimand to appear on the public register of the College.
2. The Registrar is directed to suspend Mr. Feng's Certificate of Registration for a period of six (6) months, effective December 1, 2017, three (3) months of which are to be eliminated if conditions 3a and 3b are fulfilled within three (3) months of the date of this Order. If the registrant has not fulfilled the conditions in 3a and 3b within three (3) months of the date of this Order then the entire six (6) month suspension will be served by the registrant.
3. The Registrar is directed to impose the following terms, conditions or limitations on Mr. Feng's Certificate of Registration:
  - a. Within six (6) months of the date of the Discipline Hearing, Mr. Feng must provide proof, acceptable to the Registrar, of successful completion of the College's Professionalism Workshop, which is to be taken at his own expense; and
  - b. Within six (6) months of the date of the Discipline Hearing, Mr. Feng must provide proof, acceptable to the Registrar, of successful completion of the College's Standards and Regulations Workshop, which is to be taken at his own expense.
4. For greater certainty, Mr. Feng's obligation to comply with the conditions and limitations on his Certificate of Registration is not relieved by serving the entire suspension referred to in

paragraph 2 above.

5. Mr. Feng is required to pay to the College costs in the amount of \$1800.00 within nineteen (19) months of the date of the Discipline Hearing, such payment to be submitted by providing eighteen (18) post-dated cheques in the amount of \$100.00, commencing on the first day of the first month after the Discipline Hearing, and the first day of each successive month thereafter.
