Discipline Hearing Summary – Luong Thieu, RMT (Greater Toronto Area, ON) April 11 and 12, 2016 and May 20 and 27, 2016

Decision

On September 11, 2017, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Thieu, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), not guilty of the following allegation of professional misconduct:

1. Sexual abuse of a patient.

The Discipline Committee further found that Mr. Thieu committed the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. Contravened a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failed to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession; and
2. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

A penalty hearing has been scheduled for February 15, 2018.
