



Notice of Undertaking/Agreement- Mr. Ye (Parker) Liu

On October 1, 2015 Mr. Liu entered into an Undertaking/Agreement with the College whereby he agreed to the following:

1. to refrain now and in the future from practising and/or holding himself out as a registered and/or regulated massage therapist, anywhere in the Province of Ontario, or elsewhere in Canada or in the United States of America;
2. to refrain now and in the future from applying for the reinstatement of his Certificate of Registration with the College, or from applying for registration with any other licensing body governing the practice of massage therapy in any other jurisdiction within Canada or the United States;
3. to refrain now and in the future from conducting, participating in or teaching, any tutoring sessions, or other course of conduct that undermines the integrity of the College's registration examinations; and
4. to pay partial costs of the investigation to the College in the amount of \$10,000 in equal monthly installments of \$500, until satisfied.
5. to publish in the College's regular publications details of the terms of this agreement and a copy of the Agreed Statement of Facts as agreed to by the parties.

Given Mr. Liu's resignation of his Certificate of Registration on April 28, 2015, his agreement to the above referenced terms and his agreement to certain facts (a copy of the [Agreed Statement of Facts](#) is attached hereby Order of a panel of the Discipline Committee dated October 7, 2015 the discipline proceedings were stayed, pending any breach of the undertaking by Mr. Liu.

A stay of proceedings is a decision by a panel of the Discipline Committee that suspends indefinitely the discipline proceedings. A panel of the Discipline Committee can subsequently lift the stay and resume the disciplinary proceedings in the event there is a breach of any of the terms as set out above.
