### **Guidelines for Requesting Paper-Based Communications**

The College of Massage Therapists of Ontario (CMTO) Council passed updates to <u>By-Law No. 8 – The Register and Registrant Information</u> which came into effect on January 1, 2016. One of the requirements of the updated by-law is that registrants must provide the College with an e-mail address for the purposes of corresponding with the College.

Where extenuating circumstances prevent a registrant from communicating with the College by e-mail, the College may consider communicating with the registrant using paper-based communication. Requests to have paper-based communication with the College must be made in writing with documentation supporting the grounds for the request. A request will only be granted when a registrant is able to demonstrate that they are experiencing extraordinary extenuating circumstances.

#### What is an extenuating circumstance?

An extenuating circumstance is an event or situation that is outside the control of the registrant and is severe enough to account for a registrant's inability to correspond with CMTO by e-mail. Extenuating circumstances could include, but are not limited to, situations where a registrant experiences a sudden and/or unavoidable impact to their lives, such as:

- An illness or disability that makes it impossible to communicate by e-mail or to sit in front of a computer or laptop for long periods of time (Please submit medical documentation that establishes that this particular accommodation is necessary)
- Living in a remote area that does not have access to the internet and/or Wi-Fi connections

#### Submitting a request to have Paper-Based Communications with the CMTO:

- Requests must be made in writing using the attached Paper-Based Communications Request Form
- Extenuating circumstances must be documented and indicate how/why the circumstance has led to an inability to provide an e-mail address for the purposes of corresponding with CMTO
- The registrant must submit documentation related to the reason why they are requesting to have paperbased communications with CMTO
