Discipline Hearing Summary – Registrant B, RMT May 22, June 3, October 9, 2014

Decision

On May 22, June 3 and October 9, 2014, the Discipline Committee considered allegations of professional misconduct brought against Registrant B, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT). The Discipline Committee made no findings with respect to the following alleged acts of professional misconduct:

- 1. sexual abuse of a client;
- 2. contravening a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession;
- engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee found that the College had not met its burden of proving the allegations of professional misconduct on a balance of probabilities.
