Discipline Summary Clency Ah Lan (Thornhill, ON) August 9, 2019

Motion Decision

On August 9, 2019, the Discipline Committee granted the College's motion to indefinitely adjourn the discipline hearing of Mr. Ah Lan in relation to a matter in which he was alleged to have engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

- sexually abusing a client;
- 2. contravening of a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession;
- 3. doing anything to a client for a therapeutic or other health related purpose in a situation in which consent is required, without such a consent;
- 4. physically abusing a client; and/or
- 5. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Panel granted the motion after the College explained that Mr. Ah Lan had signed an undertaking to resign and never reapply for registration with the College, and that the College could prosecute Mr. Ah Lan if he were to breach the undertaking.
