Discipline Summary

Bradley Newstead (Kingston, ON)

November 20, 2018

Motion Decision

On November 20, 2018, the Discipline Committee granted the College's motion to indefinitely adjourn the discipline hearing of Mr. Newstead in relation to a matter in which he was alleged to have engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

- sexually abusing a client;
- 2. contravening of a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession;
- 3. verbally or physically abusing a client; and/or
- 4. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Panel granted the motion after the College explained that Mr. Newstead had signed an undertaking to resign and never reapply for registration with the College, and that the College could prosecute Mr. Newstead if he were to breach the undertaking.
