Discipline Summary

September 5, 2019

Motion Decision

On September 5, 2019, the Discipline Committee granted the College's motion to indefinitely adjourn the discipline hearing of Ms. Hill-Jackson in relation to a matter in which she was alleged to have engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

- 1. contravening of a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession;
- 2. falsifying a record relating to her practice;
- 3. signing or issuing, in her professional capacity, a document that she knew contained a false or misleading statement;
- 4. submitting an account or charge for services that she knew were false or misleading;
- engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstance, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
- 6. engaging in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by registrants as conduct unbecoming a massage therapist.

The Panel granted the motion after the College explained that Ms. Hill-Jackson had signed an undertaking to resign and never reapply for registration with the College, and that the College could prosecute Ms. Hill-Jackson if she were to breach the undertaking.
