Discipline Hearing Summary – Daryosh Goldar, RMT (Great Toronto Area, ON) July 20-21, 2017 and August 23-24, 2017

Decision

On September 13, 2017, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Goldar, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

- 1. Sexually abused a patient;
- 2. Abused a client verbally or physically;
- 3. Engaged in conduct or performed an act, relevant to the practice of the profession, that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
- 4. Engaged in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming of a Massage Therapist.

Pursuant to subsection 51(4.2)(c) of the Health Professions Procedural Code, the Panel made an interim order suspending Mr. Goldar's Certificate of Registration immediately upon making a finding that he had sexually abused a patient and the sexual abuse involved touching of a sexual nature. Accordingly, the Panel made an interim order effective September 13, 2017, suspending Mr. Goldar's Certificate of Registration pending a penalty hearing.
