

Discipline Hearing Summary

Registrant C, RMT

November 6 and 7, 2014 and February 11, 12 and 13, 2015

Decision

On November 6 and 7, 2014 and February 11, 12 and 13, 2015, the Discipline Committee considered allegations of professional misconduct brought against Registrant C¹, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT). The Discipline Committee made no findings with respect to the following alleged acts of professional misconduct:

- 1. sexual abuse of a client;
- 2. contravening a standard of practice of the profession or a published standard of the College or failing to maintain the standard of practice of the profession; and/or
- 3. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regarding to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee found that the College had not met its burden of proving the allegations of professional misconduct on a balance of probabilities.

In accordance with s. 56(3) of the Code, the registrant's name has not been included in this summary.
