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Discipline Hearing Summary – Jun Xiao, RMT (Kawartha Lakes, ON) March 7, 2016

Decision

On March 7, 2016, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Jun Xiao, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

- 1. Signed or issued a document in his professional capacity that he knew contained false or misleading statements;
- 2. Contravened the regulations under the Massage Therapy Act, 1991;
- 3. Engaged in conduct relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
- 4. Failed to provide the required information upon renewal of his Certificate of Registration.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

- 1. Mr. Xiao is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
- 2. The Registrar is directed to suspend Mr. Xiao's Certificate of Registration for a period of four months;
- 3. The Registrar is directed to impose the following terms, conditions, and limitations on Mr. Xiao's Certificate of Registration:
 - a. Complete the College's Professionalism Workshop; and
 - b. Submit to an inspection of his practice;
- 4. Mr. Xiao is required to pay costs to the College in the amount of \$2,000; and
- 5. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the ordinary course.
