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Discipline Hearing Summary – Michelle Felicia Smith, RMT (Greater Toronto Area, ON) February 28, 2017

Decision

On February 28, 2017 the Discipline Committee found that Ms. Smith, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in connection two separate investigations in that she:

- 1. Submitted accounts or charges for services that she knew were false or misleading;
- 2. Engaged in disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional conduct;
- 3. Engaged in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming a massage therapist.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

- 1. The Registrar is directed to suspend the Registrant's Certificate of Registration for a period of 7 months, commencing on March 14, 2017, with 2 months remitted if the Registrant:
 - a. successfully completes and provides proof of completion of a Registrar approved course relating to professional ethics as a health care professional; and
 - b. provides the College with a 2-4 page report following completion of the course work set out above indicating what she has learned and how her conduct relates to the College's Charter on Professionalism.
- 2. The Registrant is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
- 3. The Registrant must pay costs to the College in the amount of \$2,500;
- 4. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the usual course.
