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Discipline Hearing Summary – Natasha Ianovsky, RMT (Concord, ON) March 11, 2016

Decision

On March 11, 2016, the CMTO's Discipline Committee found that Ms. Natasha Ianovsky, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that she:

- 1. Failed to keep records as required;
- 2. Signed or issued, in the member's professional capacity, a document that the member knew contained a false or misleading statement; and
- 3. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

- 1. Ms. lanovsky is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
- 2. The Registrar is directed to suspend Ms. Ianovsky's Certificate of Registration for a period of three months:
- 3. The Registrar is directed to impose the following terms, conditions and limitations on Ms. lanovsky's Certificate of Registration:
 - a. Complete the College's Record Keeping Course within 12 months;
 - b. Complete the College's Professionalism Workshop within 12 months;
- 4. Ms. lanovsky is required to pay costs to the College in the amount of \$2,000; and
- 5. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the ordinary course.
