Discipline Hearing Summary – Parminder Rehsi, RMT (Greater Toronto Area, ON)

June 8, 2016

Decision

On June 8, 2016, the Discipline Committee found that Ms. Parminder Rehsi, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that she:

- 1. Falsified a record relating to her practice;
- 2. Signed or issued, in her professional capacity, a document that she knew contained a false or misleading statement;
- 3. Submitted an account or charge for services that she knew was false or misleading;
- 4. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
- 5. contravened a standard of practice of the profession or a published standard of the College or failed to maintain the standard of practice of the profession.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

- 1. The Registrar is directed to suspend Ms. Rehsi's Certificate of Registration for a period of 12 months, which suspension shall be remitted by one (1) month to eleven (11) months upon the completion of the conditions in clauses 2, 3, and 6 below. Notwithstanding anything in this Joint Submission on Penalty, the suspension referred to herein shall continue indefinitely until the conditions in clauses 2, 3, and 6 below are complete;
- 2. Ms. Rehsi is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
- 3. Ms. Rehsi is required to successfully complete an approved Professionalism Workshop;
- 4. Ms. Rehsi is required to submit to an inspection of her practice within six months of resuming her practice;
- 5. Ms. Rehsi is required to pay costs to the College in the amount of \$3,300;
- 6. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the ordinary course.
