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Discipline Hearing Summary – Wei Li, RMT (Greater Toronto Area, ON) March 4, 2016

Decision

On March 4, 2016, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Wei Li, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT), committed acts of professional misconduct in that he:

- 1. Engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all of the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional as he:
 - a. Did not sign, issue, review or keep a copy of receipts that were issued under his name and RMT number between January 1, 2013 and April 24, 2014; and/or
 - b. Knew or ought to have known his name, RMT number and signature were being used on receipts for Massage Therapy services that he did not provide between January 1, 2013 and April 24, 2014;
- 2. Failed to keep records as required between January 1, 2013 and April 24, 2014.

Penalty Order and Cost Award Imposed

The Discipline Committee made the following order:

- 1. Mr. Li is required to receive a public and recorded reprimand;
- 2. The Registrar is directed to suspend Mr. Li's Certificate of Registration for a period of six months, with three months to be remitted if Mr. Li successfully completes an approved Professionalism course within three months of the date of the decision;
- 3. Mr. Li is required to submit to an inspection of his practice within 12 months of resuming his practice;
- 4. Mr. Li is required to pay costs to the College in the amount of \$1000;
- 5. The Discipline Committee's decision shall be published in the ordinary course.
