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Discipline Hearing Summary

Registrant G

December 29-30, 2020, February 5, 26 and March 30, 2021

Decision

The Discipline Committee considered allegations of professional misconduct brought against Registrant G¹, a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT). On September 27, 2021, the Discipline Committee issued its decision, making no findings with respect to the following allegations of professional misconduct:

1. sexual abuse of a client;
2. contravention of a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failure to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession, including but not limited to the following:
 - a) Communication/Public Health Standard 7: Consent
 - b) Communication/Public Health Standard 12: Draping;
3. verbal and/or physical abuse of a client; and
4. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practise of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee found that the College had not met the legal standard required to prove the allegations of professional misconduct.
