

## Discipline Summary

### Motion Decision

On March 7, 2022, the Discipline Committee granted a request brought by the College and Mr. Musson to indefinitely postpone Mr. Musson's discipline hearings. The hearings related to two (2) matters in which it was alleged that Mr. Musson engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. contravention of a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standard of Practice of the profession, in particular, the Standard for *Maintaining Professional Boundaries and Preventing Sexual Abuse* and/or *Communication/Public Health Standard 11: Pre/Post Treatment Protocol* and/or *Communication/Public Health Standard 14: Client Health Record*; and/or
2. failure to keep records as required; and/or
3. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee granted the request after it was presented with evidence that Mr. Musson signed an [undertaking](#) to resign and never reapply for registration with the College. According to that undertaking, the College retains the right to prosecute Mr. Musson if he breaches any of its terms.
