Motion Decision

On March 11, 2022, the Discipline Committee granted a request brought by the College and Mr. Tsatsaklas to indefinitely postpone Mr. Tsatsaklas's discipline hearing. The hearing related to a matter in which it was alleged that Mr. Tsatsaklas engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. failure to cooperate with the Quality Assurance Committee or any assessor appointed by that Committee; and/or
2. failure to reply appropriately or within a reasonable time to a written inquiry made by the College that requests a response; and/or
3. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and/or
4. engaging in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by registrants as conduct unbecoming a Massage Therapist.

The Discipline Committee granted the request after it was presented with evidence that Mr. Tsatsaklas signed an [undertaking](#) to resign from the College. According to that undertaking, the College retains the right to prosecute Mr. Tsatsaklas if he breaches any of its terms. The College can also reinstitute the prosecution of Mr. Tsatsaklas if he reapplies for registration with the College in the future.
