

## Discipline Hearing Summary

### George Raducanu (Toronto, ON)

**December 5, 2022 and April 4, 2023**

#### Decision

On January 3, 2023, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Raducanu engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. failed to reply appropriately or within a reasonable time to a written inquiry made by the College that requested a response; and
2. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

Mr. Raducanu failed to complete the requirements of a specified continuing education or remediation program that was ordered by the College's Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee. He also failed to respond meaningfully, or at all, to numerous College communications over telephone, email and registered mail.

#### Penalty Order and Costs Award

On April 4, 2023, the Discipline Committee issued the following order:

1. Mr. Raducanu must appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee immediately following the hearing of this matter to be reprimanded, with the fact of the reprimand and the text of the reprimand to appear on the College's public register.
2. The Registrar is directed to revoke Mr. Raducanu's Certificate of Registration, effective April 4, 2023.
3. Mr. Raducanu must pay the College costs in the amount of \$6,950 within 30 days of April 4, 2023.
