Discipline Summary

Courtney Hummer (Thunder Bay, ON)

October 23, 2023

Motion Decision

Following a hearing on October 23, 2023, the Discipline Committee granted a request brought by the College and Ms. Hummer to indefinitely adjourn Ms. Hummer's discipline hearing. The hearing related to a matter in which it was alleged that Ms. Hummer engaged in the following acts of misconduct:

- contravening a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published Standard of the College, or failing to maintain the Standards of Practice of the profession, in particular, the Standard for Maintaining Professional Boundaries and Preventing Sexual Abuse;
- 2. falsifying a record relating to her practice;
- 3. signing or issuing a document that she knows contains a false or misleading statement; and/or
- 4. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee granted the request after it was presented with evidence that Ms. Hummer signed an <u>undertaking</u> to resign and never reapply for registration with the College. According to that agreement, the College can re-open the prosecution of this matter if Ms. Hummer reapplies for registration or otherwise breaches any other term of the agreement.

The allegations in this matter remain unproven.
