I have been an RMT since 2016 and a member of CMTO Discipline Committee since 2021. I participate regularly in hearings and ongoing training relevant to this role.

My regulatory experience prior to CMTO Discipline Committee was with Kickboxing Canada and Kickboxing Ontario.

Since 2007 my roles have included, Chair of the National Thai Boxing Committee and President of Kickboxing Ontario (PSO, Provincial Sporting Organisation). As President, my mandate included building membership across the province as well as working with the Ministry of Sport representatives and club owners to ensure safety within our sport. I was responsible for overseeing the formalizing of a rules and regulations manual for the sporting discipline of Thai Boxing as it sought acceptance by the National Sports body in compliance with the Insurer, The Ministry of Sport, The International Sports Federation and adherence with Provincial and Federal laws.

I was Head Coach/Team Leader for the Canadian National Kickboxing Team from 2009- 2014.

My current role with Kickboxing Canada is Chief Official, overseeing safety in competition.

My management training at Cornell University and Ivey School of Business, and more recently with LMI (Leadership Management International) have provided me with practical organisational and planning tools while building collaborative relationships.

As our regulatory body continues to innovate, I believe that communication, transparency and the inclusion of our registrants should be central themes to the application of that mandate.
