Discipline Hearing Summary

Darcie Godwin (Sarnia, ON)

March 25, 2024

Decision

On March 25, 2024, the Discipline Committee found that Ms. Godwin engaged in the following act of professional misconduct:

1. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

Ms. Godwin was given notice of the hearing, but she did not participate.

The Discipline Committee's findings relate to Ms. Godwin's failure to comply with a decision of the Inquiries, Complaints and Reports Committee that required her to complete a specified continuing education or remediation program (SCERP). The SCERP included a requirement to submit and present a reflective paper on a Massage Therapist's obligations to keep records in a secure manner, and to complete one-on-one training with a mentor. Ms. Godwin did not comply with any of these components despite the College's repeated attempts to contact her, and despite having been granted numerous extensions.

Penalty Order and Costs Award

The Discipline Committee's order included the following:

1. The Registrar is directed to immediately revoke Ms. Godwin's Certificate of Registration; and
2. Ms. Godwin must pay the College costs in the amount of \$8,778 within 30 days of the date of the order.
