

**Discipline Summary**  
**Ujjwal Jain (Brampton, ON)**  
**October 28, 2024**

**Decision**

On October 28, 2024, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Jain engaged in professional misconduct after he admitted to:

1. being found guilty of an offence that is relevant to his suitability to practise;
2. sexually abusing a client;
3. contravening a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the standard of practice of the profession, in particular, the *Standards of Practice: Professional Boundaries, Prevention of Sexual Abuse and Draping*;
4. physically abusing a client; and
5. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee's findings relate to Mr. Jain's conduct towards a Massage Therapy client. In 2023, Mr. Jain was convicted of sexual assault in relation to this client, and the Committee found that this offence was relevant to Mr. Jain's suitability to practise Massage Therapy.

**Penalty Order and Costs Award**

The Discipline Committee's order included the following:

1. Mr. Jain is required to appear before a panel of the Discipline Committee following the hearing of this matter to be reprimanded, with the fact of the reprimand and the text of the reprimand to appear on the public register of the College;
2. The Registrar is directed to immediately revoke Mr. Jain's Certificate of Registration;

3. Mr. Jain must reimburse the College for funding that has been and that may in the future be provided to the client under the program established under section 85.7 of the Code, up to \$17,370, which is the maximum amount allowable for the client;
4. Mr. Jain must post security acceptable to the College in the amount of \$2,500 to guarantee the payment of any amounts he may be required to reimburse the College under paragraph 3 above. This can be paid in 23 monthly installments of \$104 and a final payment of \$108, with the first payment beginning 30 days from October 28, 2024;
  - a) Any amount of security provided by Mr. Jain pursuant to paragraph B4 that has not been used by March 16, 2027 will be returned to him; and
5. Mr. Jain must pay the College costs in the amount of \$5,852 which can be paid in 23 monthly installments of \$243 and a final payment of \$263, with the first payment beginning 30 days of October 28, 2024.

### **Reprimand Delivered to Mr. Jain**

The following reprimand was delivered by a panel of the Discipline Committee:

Mr. Jain, the panel acknowledges your cooperation in arriving at a joint resolution in this matter, which assisted in the process and lessened the burden of time and resources upon the College.

Having said that, this panel finds that your conduct was completely unacceptable for a Registered Massage Therapist. Massage Therapists are expected to adhere to the Standards of Practice and the legislation that govern the profession. They prohibit any activity of a sexual nature between a Massage Therapist and their client and require Massage Therapists to preserve the trust and respect of the therapeutic relationship.

Your conduct in this case breached these standards and exploited your position of trust towards your clients while they were in a vulnerable position, showing a complete disregard for your professional obligations and the public. You engaged in behaviour that violated the physical integrity of your client. You also committed a serious criminal offence, sexual assault. You, and only you, are responsible for your actions, and this type of behaviour will not be tolerated. Public protection is at the forefront of this Discipline Committee's decision-making process and this panel would not have been satisfied with any other outcome than the revocation of your Certificate of Registration.
