

## Discipline Summary

### Christopher Semenuk (London, ON)

### June 10, July 8 and 11, 2024

#### Decision

On January 9, 2025, the Discipline Committee found that Mr. Semenuk engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. contravened a standard of practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, in particular, *Technique Standard 15: Perform Breast Massage*; *Communication/Public Health Standard 7: Consent*; *Communication/Public Health Standard 12: Draping*; and the *Standard on Maintaining Professional Boundaries and Preventing Sexual Abuse*; and
2. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by registrants as disgraceful, dishonourable, or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee found that Mr. Semenuk did not adequately explain to the client the rationale for treating her breast tissue, exposed the client's breast, and massaged the client's breast without having her complete a consent form for treatment of sensitive areas.
