

Discipline Summary

Decision

On March 5, 2025, the Discipline Committee granted a request brought by the College and Ms. Cheung to indefinitely adjourn Ms. Cheung's discipline hearing. The hearing related to a matter in which it was alleged that Ms. Cheung engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. failed to attend an oral caution of the Complaints Committee or an oral reprimand of the Discipline Committee; and
2. engaged in conduct or performed an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Discipline Committee granted the request after it was presented with evidence that Ms. Cheung signed an [undertaking](#) where she agreed to never reapply for registration with the College or any other Massage Therapy regulatory body in Canada. Ms. Cheung had previously resigned her Certificate of Registration with the College.

According to the undertaking, the College can re-open the prosecution of this matter if Ms. Cheung applies for registration or otherwise breaches any other terms of the undertaking.

The allegations in this matter remain unproven.
