Registrant C

Decision

On January 6, 2025, the Ontario Massage Therapists Discipline Tribunal (OMTDT) issued a decision dismissing the following allegations of professional misconduct against Registrant C:

1. sexual abuse of a client;
2. contravening a standard of practice of the profession or a published standard of the College or failing to maintain the standard of practice of the profession, in particular the standards for Prevention of Sexual Abuse and/or Professional Boundaries;
3. abusing a client verbally or physically;
4. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional; and
5. engaging in conduct that would reasonably be regarded by members as conduct unbecoming a massage therapist.

The panel determined that the College did not prove the allegation that the Registrant cupped and/or grabbed a client's breast without her consent. Consequently, the panel made no findings of professional misconduct.
