



Discipline Summary

Decision

On March 27, 2026, the Ontario Massage Therapists Discipline Tribunal (Tribunal) granted a request brought by the College and Mr. Deng to indefinitely adjourn Mr. Deng's discipline hearing. The hearing related to a matter in which it was alleged that Mr. Deng engaged in the following acts of professional misconduct:

1. sexual abuse of a patient;
2. verbal or physical abuse of a patient;
3. contravening a Standard of Practice of the profession or a published standard of the College, or failing to maintain the standard of practice of the profession, in particular, the standards for *Maintaining Professional Boundaries* and *Preventing Sexual Abuse*
4. failing to keep records as required; and
5. engaging in conduct or performing an act relevant to the practice of the profession that, having regard to all the circumstances, would reasonably be regarded by members as disgraceful, dishonourable or unprofessional.

The Tribunal granted the request after it was presented with evidence that Mr. Deng had resigned his Certificate of Registration and signed an [undertaking](#) agreeing to never reapply for registration with this College or any other massage therapy regulatory body in Canada. According to the undertaking, the College can re-open the prosecution of this matter if Mr. Deng applies for registration or otherwise breaches any other terms of the undertaking.
