I have been an RMT in Ontario for 26 years and have owned a clinical practice for 23 years with a multidisciplinary staff of 15 and a focus on areas of chronic conditions and pain management, I manage an active license with FSRA for MVAs since 2010 as well as a Federal Procurement number with the government for direct referrals from CAF and Veterans Affairs.
